The submission process requires registration to create an EasyChair account, prior to submission. Authors may submit full-length papers, research-in-progress papers, abstracts, or proposals for special panels and invited sessions through this system by the above-mentioned deadline. After initial screening by the Program chair, all submissions will be double-blind reviewed before acceptance letters are sent to the author(s).

*Submission of a paper to the SSE conference will be held to contain unpublished work that is not being submitted to any other association members of the Federation of Business Discipline.*
